## SLOVENIA

### LAKE BLEED – in the kingdom of the Goldhorn

#### Day 1: LAKE BLEED

Transfer from Ljubljana Airport to the hotel in Bled. Lake Bled has been nicknamed »the Pearl of the Alps« and arguably the most beautiful Alpine lake.

#### Day 2: LAKE BLEED

Sightseeing tour of Bled with a boat-ride to the lake island and a ring of the wish-fulfilling bell. A visit to the Bled Castle atop of the cliff overlooking the lake is another highlight. From Spring to Fall a visit to Vintgar gorge is another delight. In summer you can spend the rest of the day lying on the sun and swimming in the lake or do an afternoon cycling tour to the nearby Bohinj Lake.

#### Day 3: LAKE BLEED - LJUBLJANA

Morning drive (45 minutes) to Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia. Sightseeing of the city nestled between the Castle and the river Ljubljanica. Find out why Ljubljana got its name (in Slavic language the word means »the beloved one«). Possibility of shopping in one of the largest Malls in Europe. Transfer to Ljubljana Airport.

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF SLOVENIA: LJUBLJANA with a slice of Bled a visit to Postojna cave**

### **Day 1: LJUBLJANA**

Transfer from Ljubljana Airport to the hotel in the city of Ljubljana. Dinner out and an evening stroll along the Ljubljanica river is highly recommended, for party goers there's enough action until late night.

### **Day 2: LJUBLJANA – POSTOJNA CAVE**

Star of the walking tour of the city with the visit of the famous Triple Bridges, the narrow streets of the Old town and the funicular ride to the Castle, where from the Tower one can spot as much as one third of the country. A visit to the new 3D virtual museum on Slovenia history is another excellent opportunity to find out more on the vivid history of this place. Afternoon can be free or dedicated to shopping. An alternative is to make an afternoon tour to Postojna cave, the world most visited cave and the only one where a train can take you in and you can admire the formidable forms of nature.

### **Day 3: LJUBLJANA – LAKE BLEED**

Morning drive to Lake Bled, where a boat ride to the Island and a slice of the delicious Bled cream cake will make your short stay in Slovenia truly memorable. Transfer to the Airport.

## **FIVE COUNTRIES IN SIX DAYS (Slovenia, Austria, Germany, Croatia, Italy)**

### **Day 1: LJUBLJANA AIRPORT - LAKE BLEED**

Arrival to Ljubljana Airport and transfer to Lake Bled.

### **Day 2: LAKE BLEED – LJUBLJANA - LAKE BLEED**

After breakfast, sightseeing around the magnificent alpine resort of Bled, the only lake in the Alps with a small island in the middle. A traditional wooden boat called »pletna« can take you there and on the island you can climb the 99 stairs to the church to ring the »wishing bell«. From Bled castle, located atop of a cliff, you can admire the amazing panoramic alpine view. In the afternoon departure to Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia, with a medieval town core and rich baroque architecture. Return to Lake Bled in the evening.

### **Day 3: LAKE BLEED – KOENIGSEE - SALZBURG - LAKE BLEED**

After breakfast, departure for a full day's excursion to Salzburg (Austria). Mozart's birthplace, En route stop in Germany in the national park of Koenigsee. In nearby Salzburg visit to the Altstadt (old town), on the south bank of the river there is a Baroque fiesta of churches, plazas, courtyards and fountains, oozing charm as you would expect from this Mozart centre. Museums, souvenir shops, coffee houses and liqueur stores are all part of one great homage to the composer. Return to Bled.

### **Day 4: LAKE BLEED – POREC – ROVINJ – PULA - PORTOROZ**

Another full-day excursion to Croatian Istria Peninsula. Drive along the coast to visit Poreč, Rovinj and Pula. Rovinj is considered one of the most romantic Mediterranean towns and Poreč hosts a UNESCO site – Euphrasy's Basilica with beautiful mosaics. Return to Portoroz.



### **Day 5: PORTOROZ - VENICE - PORTOROZ**

In the morning departure for Venice (Italy), the floating city. La Serenissima, the Queen of the Adriatic, city of canals, bridges and palaces... On the way back to Slovenia, stop

at the Murano glass factory. Late in the afternoon, departure for Portoroz, the most popular Slovene coastal resort.

### **Day 6: PORTOROZ - LJUBLJANA AIRPORT**

Transfer from Portoroz to Ljubljana Airport and departure.

## GRAND TOUR OF SLOVENIA



### Day 1: LJUBLJANA

Upon arrival in Ljubljana you will be met and taken to your centrally located hotel. Sightseeing tour of the Slovene capital with a visit to the Castle via a funicular and optionally a river cruise.

### Day 2: LJUBLJANA – OTOČEC – KOSTANJEVICA - MOKRICE

Depart Ljubljana around noon and drive along the deep green Krka River to Otocec, an island in the middle of the river. Continue to Kostanjevica to visit the castle with an art gallery, and on to Mokrice for a candle-lit dinner in a castle hotel.

### Day 3: MOKRICE – OLIMJE – ROGATEC – ROGAŠKA SLATINA

Drive north through the Bizeljsko wine region. Enjoy wine tasting at one of the many wineries. Continue to Olimlje to visit one of Europe's oldest pharmacies and in Rogatec visit the open-air heritage museum.

### Day 4: ROGAŠKA SLATINA – PTUJ – ZREČE

Free morning to explore the lovely parks and trails of this well known health resort. Continue to Ptuj, the oldest town in Slovenia. Visit the well preserved town center and its medieval castle.

### Day 5: ZREČE – KAMNIK – BLED – KRANJSKA GORA

Morning drive to Logar-Valley, a lovely national park. Visit the Rinka Waterfalls and continue through the picturesque Tuhinje Valley to Kamnik, a romantic little town surrounded by the Alps. Afternoon drive to Bled, the pearl of the Alpine region. Dinner and overnight in Kranjska Gora, a well known ski resort near the Austrian-Italian border.

### Day 6: KRANJSKA GORA – VRŠIČ – NOVA GORICA

After breakfast, drive over the Vrsic Pass into the Trenta Valley through which one of the most beautiful European river flows.

### Day 7: NOVA GORICA – ŠTANJEL –ŠKOCJAN CAVES – LIPICA – PIRAN – PORTOROŽ

This morning is reserved for the Karst region. Walk through a typical Karst village, Stanjel, to visit a farm and see how the famous Slovenian prosciutto (ham) is prepared and taste the regional Teran wine. Continue to Lipica and visit the stud farm, then on to Skocjan to visit the wonders of the Karst underworld. Afternoon drive to the Slovene coast. Walk through the narrow streets of the picturesque town of Piran, with its strong Venetian influence.

### Day 8: PORTOROŽ - LJUBLJANA

After breakfast, you will be driven back to Ljubljana. The rest of the day is free for last-minute shopping or to visit one of the city's many museums.

### Day 9: LJUBLJANA – END OF TOUR

After breakfast you will be taken to the airport, or you may combine this stay with beautiful Croatia.

## CROATIA AT ITS BEST



### Day 1: ZAGREB

Transfer from Zagreb airport to the hotel in the Croatian capital, Zagreb.

### Day 2: ZAGREB

City tour of the Croatian capital with the visits of the historic Upper Town, St. Marks's Church, St. Catherine's Church, the Cathedral, the Parliament and the Government Palace, the Mimara museum and the Theatre. Rest of the day free to explore the old town and do what the locals do: shop!

### Day 3: ZAGREB – OPATIJA

Travel from Zagreb to the Adriatic Sea and check out the popular resort of Opatija.

### Day 4: OPATIJA – PLITVICE – ZADAR

Drive to Plitvice National Lakes (UNESCO site) and enjoy the walk around the 16 terraced lakes, its waterfalls and rapids. On to Zadar to visit the Roman ruins, the famous church of St. Donat and the natural orgues.

### Day 5: ZADAR – ŠIBENIK - TROGIR – SPLIT

Continue south to Šibenik. Visit of its Cathedral (UNESCO site), then drive on along the coast to the peninsular - shaped town Primošten. Not far away is another pearl, the medieval island town of Trogir (another UNESCO site). And on the other side of the bay its our goal for the day, the capital of Dalmatia – Split.

### Day 6: SPLIT – DUBROVNIK

Explore the historic centre of Split, built within and around the palace of Roman emperor Diocletian (another UNESCO site). Then on to Dubrovnik. (If interested in pilgrimage then a detour to Medjugorje is a must!)

### Day 7: DUBROVNIK

Discover the Pearl of the Adriatic, as often nicknamed. Visit to the famous Ramparts (probably the most complete in Europe), walk in the old town with the visit of Rector's Palace, the Bell Tower Clock, Orlando's Column and many palaces and monasteries, where among other one of the oldest pharmacy shops in the world is also sheltered.

### Day 8: DUBROVNIK – MONTENEGRO

Day tour to Montenegro: Kotor Bay (UNESCO site) and on to Budva and Sveti Štefan island.

**Day 9: DUBROVNIK**

Day at leisure, then transfer to the airport. If time permitting we suggest a visit to Konavle village or the excursion to the nearby island of Lokrum.

## Day 1: DUBROVNIK

Arrival to Dubrovnik. Dubrovnik is one of the world's best preserved walled cities and therefore under UNESCO protection. It will welcome you with a typical Dalmatian hospitality.



## Day 2: DUBROVNIK

Morning sightseeing tour will focus on the beautifully preserved medieval town with its imposing city walls. Among the highlights is the Rector's Palace, Franciscan Monastery, which houses one of the oldest pharmacies in Europe. ## JEWISH HERITAGE OF POLAND

From the 11th century till the beginning of World War II, Poland was known as the cultural and spiritual centre of European Jews. During your trip around Warsaw you will have a chance to see parts of old Jewish Warsaw, and other places connected with the rich history and traditions of Polish Jews.



### Day 1: KRAKOW

Arrival to Krakow. Transfer to Kazimierz Jewish district. Visit to Remuh synagogue and cemetery. Walking tour of Kazimierz – Krakow's old Jewish Quarter.

Transfer from Krakow to Tarnow. Sightseeing of the old Jewish town. Drive to Zbylitowska Gora and visit of the mass graves there. Return to Krakow with a stop in Krakow Plaszow. Free for individual visits and souvenir shopping. Visit to the Tempel and Kupah's Synagogue.

### Day 3: KRAKOW – AUSCHWITZ – BIRKENAU - KRAKOW

Travel to Auschwitz - Birkenau and guided tour to Auschwitz - Birkenau Extermination Camp. Afternoon return to Krakow.

### Day 4: KRAKOW

Panoramic Krakow walking city tour. Walking tour of Kazimierz Jewish district & Old Krakow city, including the Wawel hill. Visit the Market square in Krakow. Optional visit of Schindler's factory.

### Day 5: KRAKOW – LUBLIN – MAJDANEK - WARSAW

Travel by bus to Lublin. Tour of Lublin cemetery and Yeshiva Chachmei, the Talmudic school, now housing a synagogue. Transfer to Majdanek and visit of the concentration and extermination camp. Continuation to Warsaw and evening arrival to Polish capital.

### Day 6: WARSAW

Full day guided tour of Warsaw and the Jewish sites, including the site of the Warsaw ghetto and the uprising monument, Nozyk Synagogue and Okopowa Cemetery, Umschlagplatz, etc. In the afternoon visit of the royal route, royal castle, gothic St. Johny Cathedral, old market square, Lazienki Royal Park and the nearby Belvedere Palace.



**Day 7: TREBLINKA - WARSAW**

Transfer from Warsaw to Treblinka Death Camp. Visit of the monument. Afternoon return to Warsaw and departure.
