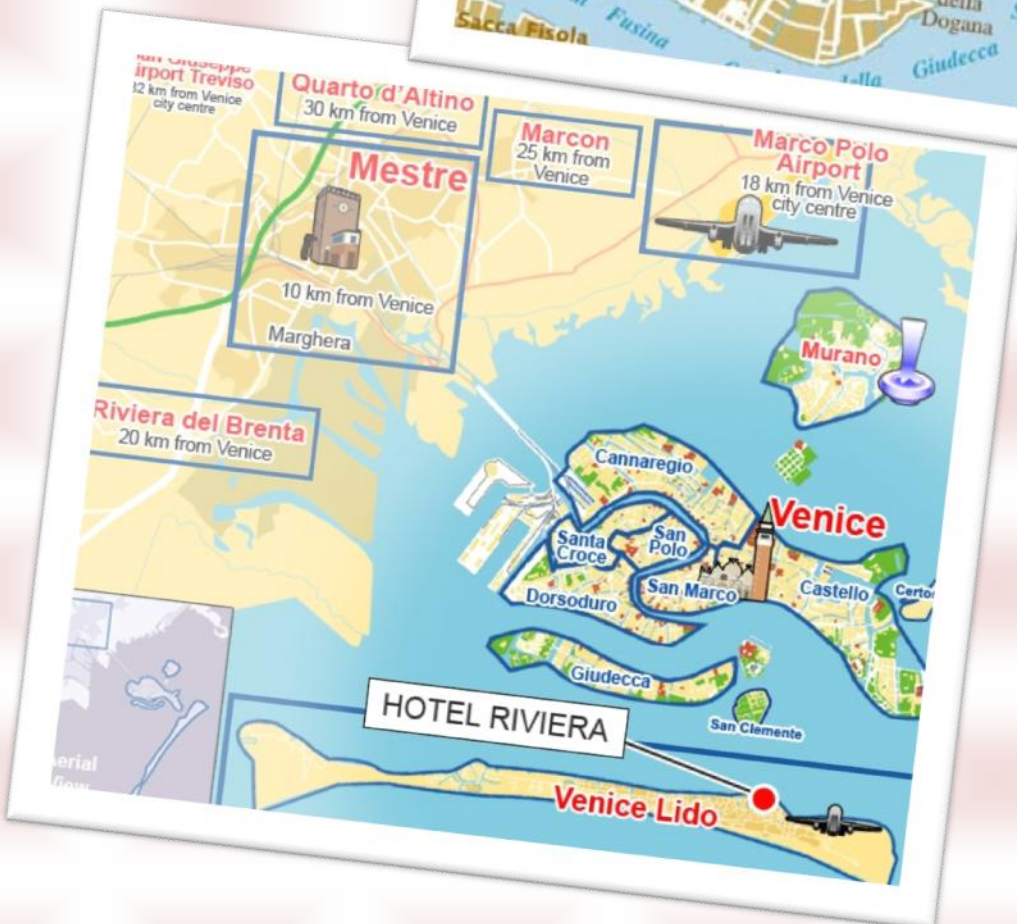

HOW TO GET FROM MARCO POLO AIRPORT TO VENICE?

Private Motorboat Transfer

∞ **Motoscafo – Water Taxi**

the water taxi gets the tourist from the airport directly to the hotel, the trip takes appr. 20 min

∞ **Vaporetto – Water Bus**

the regular lines with boats departing every hour, the trip takes up to 50 min

∞ **Bus**

Two companies ATVO (blue buses , fast line) and ACTV (orange buses,several stops on the way) operate the buses which run from the airport to Piazzale Roma, ATVO bus needs 25 min to reach Venice

Venice's Grand Canal is lined with magnificent buildings. The 15th century Palazzo Santa Sofia or Ca' d'Oro (House of Gold) is one of the most beautiful among them.



∞ St. Mark's Square

Possibly the world's most famous square and Venice 's principal square is surrounded by magnificent historic buildings. Several of Venice's major sights are located here, so the square is often crowded with tourists.

∞ Rialto Bridge

Venice's famous Rialto Bridge was long the only bridge crossing the Grand Canal between the San Marco and San Polo districts. The bridge was built in the 16th century and is covered with shops.

∞ Bridge of Sighs

This legendary covered bridge connects the palace of the Doges with the prison cells across the Rio di Palazzo. The bridge is one of the most famous sights in Venice.

Ghetto – Jewish District in Venice

∞ Ghetto Nuovo

There are three buildings of synagogues (schole) *Schola Grande Tedesca* (German Synagogue est. 1528) *Schola Canton* (1532) and *Schola Italiana* from 1575.

In 1954 the Jewish Community of Venice founded the Museo Ebraico which is situated of the ground floor of German Synagogue.

The ticket to the museum allows entry to the three synagogues.

On the side of the main square *Campo del Ghetto Nouovo* there is the monument of Holocaust with names of the Jews taken from Venice to the Concentration camps during WWII.

∞ Ghetto Vecchio

There are two buildings of working synagogues *Schola Levantine* (1541), and the biggest Venetian synagogue *Schola Spagnola* founded about 1580.



Along the main street *Calle del Ghetto Vecchio* there are numerous Jewish shops including sweet shop Panificio Volpe, antiques in Stamperia del Ghetto and Nesher e Nesher.

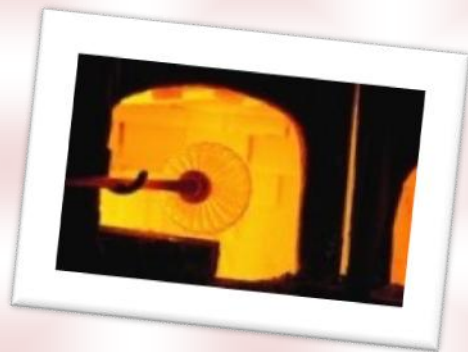

Islands you have to visit

• MURANO

Murano is a series of islands linked by bridges in the Venetian Lagoon (about 1.5 km north of Venice). It is famous for its glass making, particularly lampworking. It was once an independent comune, but is now a frazione of the comune of Venice.

Today, Murano is home to the Museo Vetrario or Glass Museum in the Palazzo Giustinian, which holds displays on the history of glassmaking as well as glass samples ranging from Egyptian times through the present day.



• BURANO

Burano is an island in the Venetian Lagoon. It is known for its lacework and for its small, brightly-painted houses, popular with artists. The colours of the houses follow a specific system originating from the golden age of its development. Other attractions include the Church of San Martino, with a tilting campanile and a painting by Giambattista Tiepolo, the Oratorio di Santa Barbara and the Museum and School of Lacemaking.



• TORCELLO

Torcello is a quiet and sparsely populated island in the Venetian Lagoon. It is the oldest continuously populated region of Venice. Today one of its main attractions is the Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta, founded in 639. One of its walls is completely covered with a wonderful Byzantine mosaic representing "Il Giudizio Universale". Other attractions are the 11th and 12th century Church of Santa Fosca, which is surrounded by a porticus in form of a Greek cross, and a museum housed in two



fourteenth century palaces, the Palazzo dell'Archivio and the Palazzo del Consiglio, which was once the seat of the communal government. The Church of Santa Fosca has outwardly an octagonal frame with three apses. The central one has two rows of arcades and an harmonious colonnade. On the altar you can admire a beautiful sculpture from XV century which represents Santa Fosca. Another sight for tourists is an ancient stone chair, known as Attila's Throne. It has, however, nothing to do with the king of the Huns, but it was most likely the podestà's or the bishop's chair. Torcello is also home to a Devil's Bridge, known as the Ponte del Diavolo or alternatively the Pontecello del Diavolo.

Excursions out of Venice

• VERONA

This beautiful city is one of the main tourist destinations in northern Italy, owing to its artistic heritage, several annual fairs, shows, and operas, such as the lyrical season in the Arena, the ancient amphitheatre built by the Romans. Verona is most famous for the setting of Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet.



• PADUA

The city is picturesque, with a dense network of arcaded streets opening into large communal piazze, and many bridges crossing the various branches of the Bacchiglione, which once surrounded the ancient walls like a moat. Padua is also the setting for most of the action in





Shakespeare's *The Taming of the Shrew*. Millions of pilgrims come to Padua every year to visit the Basilica di Sant'Antonio, where the grave of Sant'Antonio is preserved. Another reason to visit this city is Giotto. In Padua you will find the most complete and also the best preserved collection of works by Giotto.

- **RAVENNA**

Most people visit Ravenna for its superb Byzantine mosaics. At first it looks much like any other Italian city, with old streets, fine shops and peaceful squares, but the Byzantine domes of its churches still evoke its Eastern heritage. Ravenna's early Christian churches and mosaics have been collectively designated a World Heritage Site. As an extra bonus, Ravenna is a great place to taste the famously delicious food of the Emilia-Romagna region.
